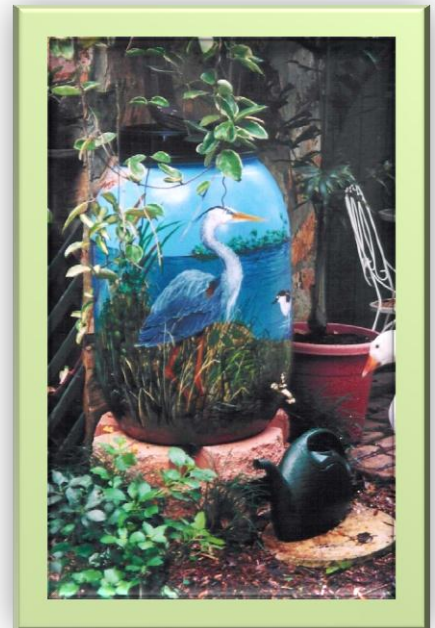

Helpful Information

- 1) The Art on a Rain Barrel Design contest is open to any business, municipality or organization willing to exercise their creativity on behalf of water conservation, stewardship and community development.
- 2) Registration forms must be submitted by December 31st, 2012 in order for your business to be considered for the contest.
- 3) Completed registration forms must be submitted electronically by email to marketing@brevardcountyfair.com or faxed to 321-633-1890.
- 4) Organizations will have until Sunday, March 18th, 2012 to complete their designs and return the rain barrels for judging. Rain barrels MUST be brought to the Brevard County Fairgrounds (3845 N Wickham Road, Melbourne FL 32935) on Monday, March 19th from 11:00am-7:00pm.
- 5) Rain barrels will be judged by our panelists on Tuesday, March 20th 2012 and the winning entries in the contest.
- 6) The entered rain barrels will be on display at the Brevard County Fair from March 22nd-April 1st, 2012.
- 7) Organizations will have their name displayed next to their rain barrel in a frame at the Brevard County Fair.
- 8) All participants will be able to keep their Rain Barrel for use at their business/municipal or organization facility.
- 9) It is expected that all rain barrels are installed properly for the intended use.

What is a Rain Barrel?

A rain barrel is a 55-gallon recycled food-grade plastic barrel that is placed at the outlet of a roof gutter to catch rooftop runoff during a storm (referred to as “stormwater”). When stormwater runs off of impervious surfaces like roofs, parking lots, compacted soils, and roads, it accumulates fine sand, nutrients like phosphorus, bacteria from animal wastes, oil, grease and heavy metals from cars, and delivers these pollutants to nearby rivers and streams. Stormwater threatens the integrity of our drinking water source, the water quality of streams that we swim in, and the habitat of fish and other aquatic life. Rain barrels are an important part of the solution, as they intercept stormwater before it runs across the landscape and into our waterways. The stormwater collected in a rain barrel can be used to water lawns and gardens, thereby conserving water and protecting water quality.
