1. Create an art piece or reusable item using materials that would have otherwise been garbage or recycled.
 - a. Clothing Accessories- A hair piece, hat, belt, necklace, ring, are all ideas for this category.
 - b. Useful item- (reuse/recycle an item into another useful item-eg. making plastic bottles into a floating raft)
 - c. Posters- Make an informative or encouraging poster about recycling, reducing, and/or reuse 8.5 x 11 please
 - d. Art Work/Decoration- eg. -Make a Christmas or Easter decoration for your home from items that would have been thrown away.
2. Complete the registration form.
3. Bring your entry to the County Fair at Wickham Park on March 19th between 11:00am-8:00pm or make special arrangements Keep Brevard Beautiful office, 1620 Adamson Rd, Cocoa March 16, 17, 18 between 8am-5pm or mail by school courier to Keep Brevard Beautiful.
4. **Judging is Tuesday, March 20th, 2012 with at least 6 prizes (\$25 each) for Best of Show, Most Creative, First Place (K-3), First Place (grade 4-6), First Place (grade 7-8) and First Place (grade 9-12), with certificates and ribbons also being awarded.**
